- **Provide Refreshments:** Offer light refreshments for your guests. This can be tailored to your business and the occasion.
- **Be Present:** On the agreed-upon date and time, be prepared to meet and greet your guests, including community leaders and Chamber members.
- **Prepare a Brief Business Introduction:** Share a brief synopsis of your business, which will be used for announcements by the Chamber and local Newspapers. This will help attendees learn more about your company and its offerings.

Chamber Responsibilities: We will assist in ensuring the event is a success by handling the following:

- **Event Coordination:** We will work with you to select a suitable date and time and help organize all logistics.
- **Invitations:** The Chamber will invite members, the Chamber Board, City Manager, and City Council members to attend your ceremony.
- Event Coverage: We will contact local newspapers to cover the event and help promote your business.
- **Ribbon & Scissors:** The Chamber will provide the ceremonial ribbon and large scissors for the official Ribbon Cutting moment.
